NOTIFICATION

The Academic Council, vide resolution no. 33 in its 60th meeting held on 08.02.2023, on the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, has approved the following "Rules for Additional Subjects at Graduation level" only in non-practical papers to the pass out students of B.A./B.Sc. (Hons.)/B.Sc. (General)/ B.Com. (Pass Course)/ B.A. (Pass Course)/B.Ed. Course:

- A candidate who has passed three year degree course of this University will appear in additional subject(s) (MAXIMUM TWO) of B.A./B.Sc. (Hons.)/ B.Sc.(General)/ B.Com (Pass Course)/ B.A, (Pass Course) only in non-practical subjects in the subsequent examinations except in the subject(s) in which he/she has already passed the course. The examinations of 1st and 2nd semesters for Part-I shall be conducted with regular students of these semesters. Part-I examinations are mandatory to clear by a candidate to be promoted to the Part-II (3rd & 4th semester) examinations, otherwise, he/she has to apply afresh for the additional subject examinations. No extra chance will be provided to the Part-I examinations. The candidate who cleared Part-I (1st &2nd semester) examinations will be eligible to appear in Part-II (3rd semester & 4th semester) examinations and Part-III (5th & 6th Semester) examinations to be conducted with regular students of these semesters respectively. Only one extra chance will be provided to the candidates to clear their re-appear examinations of Part-II (3rd & 4th semester) & Part-III (5th & 6th semester) examinations, if any, with the next semester examinations of regular students of these courses respectively.
- A candidate who has already passed the examinations for the degree of Bachelor of Education from this University will opt as an additional subject from any of the subjects other than those in which he/she has already passed. The examinations of B.Ed. additional subject(s) shall be held annually with the examinations of regular students for Part-I & Part-II simultaneously. Only one extra chance will be provided to the candidates to clear their reappear examinations of both parts with the reappear examinations of Bachelor of Education. Before applying for these examinations of additional subject of B.Ed., the candidates must read the following instructions carefully:

 In the case of a teaching subject the candidate must have already passed the degree examinations in that subject.

- In addition to the written paper of teaching subject, the candidate shall undergo a
 practical test in the teaching of the additional subject taken by him/her.
- The candidate (s) who will not clear the examinations of additional subjects within the time frame/chances will have to apply afresh. No extra/mercy chance will be given to such candidates.
- 4. The candidate(s) who desirous of appearing in the additional subject examinations shall apply online with requisite fee of Rs. 2000/- per semester (for semester courses) and Rs. 3000/- per year (for yearly course).

- For examinations, current syllabi in the subject concerned shall be applicable but the scheme 5. of marks for the said subject shall be as 100 Maximum Marks (Conversion of 50/70/80 marks etc. of theory paper as applicable in regular graduation course, the fraction of .5 or more shall be considered as higher side, but less than .5 shall be considered in lower side).
- Candidate can choose the additional subject(s) (MAXIMUM TWO) from the subject 6. combination available in the current scheme & syllabi of the course concerned.
- Passing percentage shall be same as applicable in Ordinance of three-year degree course 7. concerned /Bachelor of Education Degree concerned.
- Examinations Schedule including filling of examinations from shall be same as notified by 8. the University for regular and re-appear students as the case may be. Further, Odd semester main examination of additional subjects will be held with the even semester main examinations of that course.
- The candidate(s) shall not be required to submit the Migration Certificate in the University for 9. additional subject(s) examinations.
- No separate degree certificate will be issued for the additional subjects. Only the Detailed Marks Card (DMC) of additional subject(s) examination shall be issued separately/year wise by the Examination Branch.
